COVID 19

The safety of our event participants (including all runners, event crew and members of the public) is of paramount importance. We have carefully planned the Warwick Reindeer Run so that it remains safe for all but also an enjoyable and fun race!

Please take note of the following:

- If you feel unwell, or develop symptoms of COVID 19 in the days prior to the race, please do not attend.
- We ask all entrants to take a Lateral Flow Test in the lead up to the race. If you test positive, you must self isolate and you must not attend the race. Although we do not require proof of taking a test, we trust that our runners will take personal responsibility for the safety of everyone involved in the race.
- You may wear a face mask if you wish to, although this will not be mandatory.
- There will be QR codes available to scan at registration for the NHS Test and Trace app.
- Please observe a safe social distance throughout the event, especially in the event HQ, the start/finish line, and at any water or refreshment station. While out on the course, please give all your fellow runners sufficient space, especially when overtaking.
- Please arrive changed and ready to race, to limit the time spent in crowded areas. Please also bring your own water if you can.

Registration and Pre-Race

- You can pick up your race number and chip from Warwick Racecourse from **7.30am until 9.30am** on race day.
- The registration tent will be outside the main grandstand.
- Once you have collected your number, please fill in your emergency contact information on the reverse.
- Plan your journey in advance and allow plenty of time to park and pick up your race number.
- Registration is a 2 minute walk from the start line on inner service road of the racecourse.
- Please don't risk running if you feel unwell on race day.
- Toilets will be provided in the main grandstand.

Parking

- There are two council owned pay and display car parks adjacent to the racecourse, at the northern and southern end of the grandstand and paddock area.

During the Race

- First aid will be available during the race – if you require medical assistance, or see someone who does, please inform your nearest marshal.
- Always listen to the instructions of the marshals.
- Please don't throw litter on the ground along the course – please use the bins provided, or hand your litter to a marshal!
- UKA regulations state that only bone conduction headphones are allowed during the race – this allows you to hear the instructions of marshals and be aware of your surroundings

The Route

- The route is a series of laps of the racecourse inner service road, starting and finishing opposite the main grandstand.
- 2.5km race: one lap
- 7.5km race: three laps
- There will be a drinks station next to the start finish line, and also in the finishing area.

At the Finish

- As you finish, you will collect your bespoke medal and refreshments as you exit back towards the main grandstand.
- Results will be posted on our website, www.alcester10k.com, within 24 hours of the race.
